Court of Trees Rules 2023

*Trees will be ready to Decorate Tuesday November 28th Noon.
Call the Recreation Office if you need more information 209-394-8830*

*Families can start decorating on Tuesday 11/28th through **6pm** Thursday
November 30th. Light tests and Judging will take place Thursday Evening at 7pm.
Grand lighting Friday 12/1 at 6:30pm*

1. **YOU MAY USE LED lights ONLY** - any type of LEDs will be fine. We recommend 4-5 strings per tree. This includes any tree topper
2. Use Waterproof Decorations. (water soluble glue will disintegrate during the rainy weather)
3. Secure your Decorations with Zips ties, pipe cleaners, string or other ties. The weather is unpredictable and non-secured decorations will get blown off your tree.
4. A sign will be provided and displayed for you. **NO EXTRA SIGNS OR BANNERS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FENCE OR, ON OR AROUND YOUR TREE.** Fences are in place both to provide a unified and attractive view of the Christmas Tree Forest and to detract visitors from touching trees.
5. You must provide One 10 to 15 foot outdoor-rated extension cord. (Label with your name and place under your tree).
6. If you bring small children with you remember to teach them to respect others trees. If your child is caught vandalizing (accident or intentionally) another's tree you will be charged accordingly and will lose your privilege of decorating with no refund. ** This includes pets. They must be on a leash and stay within your area. So not to leave any unwanted poop or urine in the area
7. Once the Court of trees is set up and ready for public viewing we ask that unless you have a problem with your tree, no one goes inside the fenced area.
8. The City is not responsible for any damage or theft to your tree. If you see any destruction or theft occurring call the Police Department.
9. SET UP- You must be set up by Thursday Evening when the light test will occur.
10. TAKE DOWN- You must remove all your decorations and lights prior to December 28th. If you have not done this everything will be thrown away when the trees are removed.
