

Frequently Asked Questions and Important Dates for Livingston 2018 Swim Team – Livingston Waves

When does practice Start and do I have to go to practice?

Practices will start Tuesday May 1st from 5pm – 6:30pm and will run Monday, Tuesday and Wednesdays until June 11th. After June 11th practices will run Monday, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons, 5pm – 6:15pm. Stroke Clinics will be available during the day as scheduled.

Who is my coach?

Jill Friesen is the Waves head Coach who is a year round ASA Swimmer, on the LHS Swim Team and Water polo Team and this is her first year as head coach. Assistant coach will be announced when we get one.

Do I get a UNIFORM and what else do I need to get?

Uniforms will be ordered sometime in May. Traditionally jammers run about \$30 and Suits \$50 to \$60. If you have a suit from last year that fits you will not need to order one. Signs will be posted and you will get a text about suit orders.

When are the Meets?

Meet Schedule will be given out prior to June 11th. Meets are Friday evenings and possible a couple Saturday Mornings. We have joined Patterson and Riverbank Recreation Teams and it looks like we will go to their pools and host a meet ourselves.

When are pictures?

Pictures will be taken in June and time and date will be announced. More information will follow. PICTURES ARE NOT INCLUDED in league fees. Pictures will arrive 4 weeks after they are taken.
